## SBAC Practice and Training Tests Guide-2013-2014


To assist students in taking the new SBAC Field Test this spring it is recommended that teachers have students go through the Practice and Training Tests. This is a guide to help teachers do this with their students. Note that the Practice/Training Test system will be unavailable on the following dates:

## Practice/Training Test Downtime Sunday, February 9, 2014

- 1. Go to the SBAC Protal web site: <a href="http://sbac.portal.airast.org/ca/">http://sbac.portal.airast.org/ca/</a>
- 2. Select the green **Practice and Training Tests** on the right.



3. **Note** that the following browsers can be used: Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, MS Internet Explorer 10 (some computers may need this updated to this version) and Apple Safari. Select the **Student Interface Practice and Training Test** on the right.






4. Click on **Sign In.** The students will all do this as a guest.



5. From the **Grade** drop down the student will select their grade level. Then click on **Yes** at the bottom.




6. Students will then select either an ELA or Math practice test.



NOTE: The **Training Tests** should be done first as training on how to use the new test interface. It is a short, 9-questions test. The **Practice Tests** are longer (about 20-questions). The **Performance Tests** require some activities to be done before testing. These activities can be found on the **Resources and Documentations** page indicated in step 3 of this guide.

7. The **Choose Settings** page is for changes to some of the features of the test interface. It is recommended to leave these settings as they are.



8. The **Is this Your Test**? Page is just showing what the settings are for the **Choose Setting** page. Click on **Yes Start My Test** at the bottom.



9. the **Test Instructions and Help** page is a scollable page which goes over all of the features of the test interface. <u>TELL THE STUDENTS NOT TO CLICK BEGIN TEST NOW</u>. <u>This page is an imaportant page for teachers to know and go over with their students</u>. Once that is done students will click on **Begin Test Now** at the bottom.
